We cut to a shot of streamer's hands holding the Razer Ripsaw close to the camera.

Dialogue: The Razer Ripsaw X is a 4K 30FPS capture card for your DSLRs and wireless cameras.

We cut to a shot of streamer's hands holding the Razer Ripsaw X product box close to the camera and displaying all sides of it.

Cut to a close-up shot of streamer's hands connecting the Ripsaw X's Type-A connector to his PC's USB 3.0 port. He then connects a HDMI cable to the receiving end of the Ripsaw X.

Dialogue: Just plug the USB into your PC's 3.0 port and grab your HDMI 2.0 and plug it into the opposite end, and then – bam!

Cut to picture-in-picture mode where the streamer demonstrates how seamlessly this process works from a mini window as he syncs content with his PC's streaming software in the larger window.

Dialogue: The software picks up the signal from the Ripsaw and then we can just kind of scale this, and it fits perfectly.

As the streamer says 'scale this', we see his mini window enlarging to take over the entire screen.

Text appears: Fits perfectly.

Cut to the streamer signing off on an appreciative note as he looks directly into the camera.

Dialogue: And again, Razer, thanks so much for sending me the products.

Razer logo appears.

Razer Chroma RGB logo appears.
